



Application and safety instructions for brushes used for brush cutters and weeders

PLEASE CAREFULLY READ THE INSTRUCTIONS BEFORE USING THE BRUSH!

The brush is especially designed for removing weeds with the use of brushcutters and weeding machines.

Attention: there are possible risks for both the environment as for humans that may come with the use of the brush. These risks include:

- Loud sounds and dust;
- Sparks that can result in fire hazards (only applicable to steel brushes);
- Blockage of the brush and wire breakage;
- Loose parts that can cause danger, such as wires, ground, stones and branches;
- Recoil when fixed objects such as trees and walls get hit and unexpected manoeuvres of the machine/device;
- Clothes that may come in contact with the machine/device and the risk of cut injuries;
- Poor fitting of the brush to the machine/device;
- Coming into contact with the electrical supply cable if present.

Safety measures

- Always carefully read the instructions and comply to the instruction that belong to the machine/device and work away from the body;
- Wear protecting clothes as shown in this manual;
- Alert surrounding people for the possible dangers;
- Prevent that people, animals and objects get hit by flying objects as stones, branches, wires and ground. Immediately stop using the brush when there are people, animals or objects nearby that could possibly be damaged/injured;
- Check whether there are no flammable products/materials present in the area;
- Never remove the protective cover and do not use the brush when it is damaged, unstable or rusted. In addition, do not use the brush when there are other notable parts that deviate from the original product;
- Always verify the max. rotation speed (RPM) of the machine/device. Please do not use the brush if the rotation speed is higher than mentioned on the brush;
- Turn off the machine/device after using it and unplug the cable, if present.

Use the following steps in case of an emergency

- Consult your workplace first-aidier or contact your physician for assistance;
- In case of emergencies call 999;
- Report all workplace accidents to your supervisor immediately.

Assembly of the brush

- Only use the included components as advised by the manufacturer of the machine/device;
- Make sure that the brushes are correctly mounted.

Storage and deposit

- After use, properly store the brushes in a dry, cool environment in order to protect the brush from any damage;
- Recycle the used and worn-out brushes.
